

2014 – 10th Grade Centralized Exam News Report:

The tenth grade exam was conducted on Sunday, November 9, 2014 at predetermined centers within the Archdiocese. Proctor services were arranged with the help of several volunteers. The format of the central exam of 2014 was well received both by teachers and students. Special mention to our beloved Archbishop, His Eminence Mor Titus Yeldho, Sunday School Vice-President Rev. Fr. Saji Markose, CEP Director Rev. Dn. Vivek Alex, TSP Director Dr. Robin Chirackal and all 2014 Sunday School Board for taking time to prepare, review the question booklet, distribute and conduct exam in each region without any delay. Answer sheets were evaluated at our Archdiocesan Headquarters. Volunteers from various churches in New York, New Jersey and Philadelphia assisted with evaluation and tabulation of the answer sheets. Results were published ahead of the target date. A thorough analysis of the exam and results were done. This helped to figure out the strengths and weaknesses of our curriculum.

70 students from various churches in this Archdiocese in North America and Canada took the two hours long centralized exam that was proctored on the same day at the same time.

Kudos to all students on successfully passing the exam. This year we achieved 96% pass rate. 14 students scored 90 points or over, 13 students in the 80th percentile and the total average score is 72.95
